Grenache Barbera 2008

The label depicts the Magnificent Tree Frog *Litoria splendida*, locally known as the “Splendid Frog”. It is native only to the north of Western Australia, found in the Bungle Bungle Ranges in the Kimberley region. Its small area of habitat and the fact that it shelters from the tropical day time temperatures in caves and between boulders make it a rare find indeed.

The aim of Feet First is to produce a range of wines from fruit grown in Western Australia that are value for money. To this end, vintage variations are reduced by sourcing quality fruit from growers in a diverse range of regions, including Margaret River, Swan Valley, Mount Barker, Frankland River, Swan Valley, Pemberton and Geographe. Our aim is to maintain a level of quality that over delivers for the price asked and to be available in key markets in Australia and overseas.



Tasting Notes

The nose exhibits notes of ripe maraschino cherries and spice, complemented by the delicate cinnamon and vanilla flavours of the Oak.

A medium bodied wine with clean acids and soft tannins. Juicy red fruit characters. The structure of the Grenache is complemented by the Berry fruit characters and fresh acidity of the Barbera to create a full flavoured, approachable blend that will complement a variety of food styles
