

FEET FIRST

Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2010

The label depicts the Magnificent Tree Frog *Litoria splendida*, locally known as the "Splendid Frog". It is native only to the north of Western Australia, found in the Bungle Bungle Ranges in the Kimberley region. Its small area of habitat and the fact that it shelters from the tropical day time temperatures in caves and between boulders make it a rare find indeed.

The aim of Feet First is to produce a range of wines from fruit grown in Western Australia that are value for money. To this end, vintage variations are reduced by sourcing quality fruit from growers in a diverse range of regions, including Margaret River, Mount Barker and Frankland River and Geographe. Our aim is to maintain a level of quality that over delivers for the price asked and to be available in key markets in Australia and overseas.



Tasting Notes

This wine is an unoaked blend of Semillon (75%) and Sauvignon Blanc (25%) from fruit grown on Robertsons "Mischief" Vineyard and the International Hill Vineyard, both in the Frankland region of Western Australia.

Pale straw in colour with bright green flecks at the rim. The bouquet is attractive and herbaceous with sweet cape gooseberry fruit aromas and a hint of sweet vanilla bean. Upfront the palate is soft, crisp and fresh. Delicate flavours of pome fruits follow in the mid-palate; the finish is long and satisfying with a zing of citrus zest.

This wine is best enjoyed in its youth for its lively fruit characters as an aperitif or with salads and white meat dishes.
